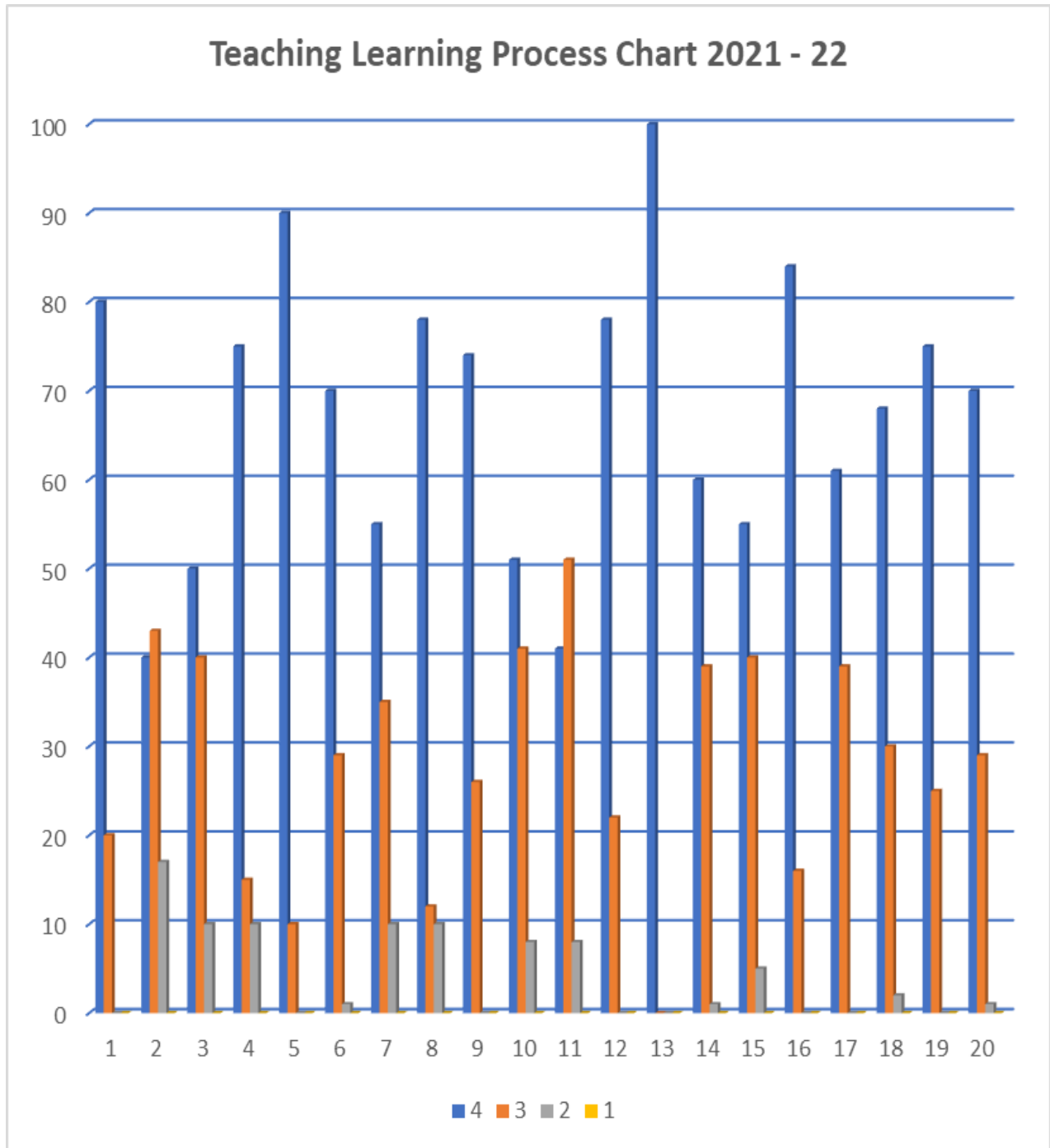

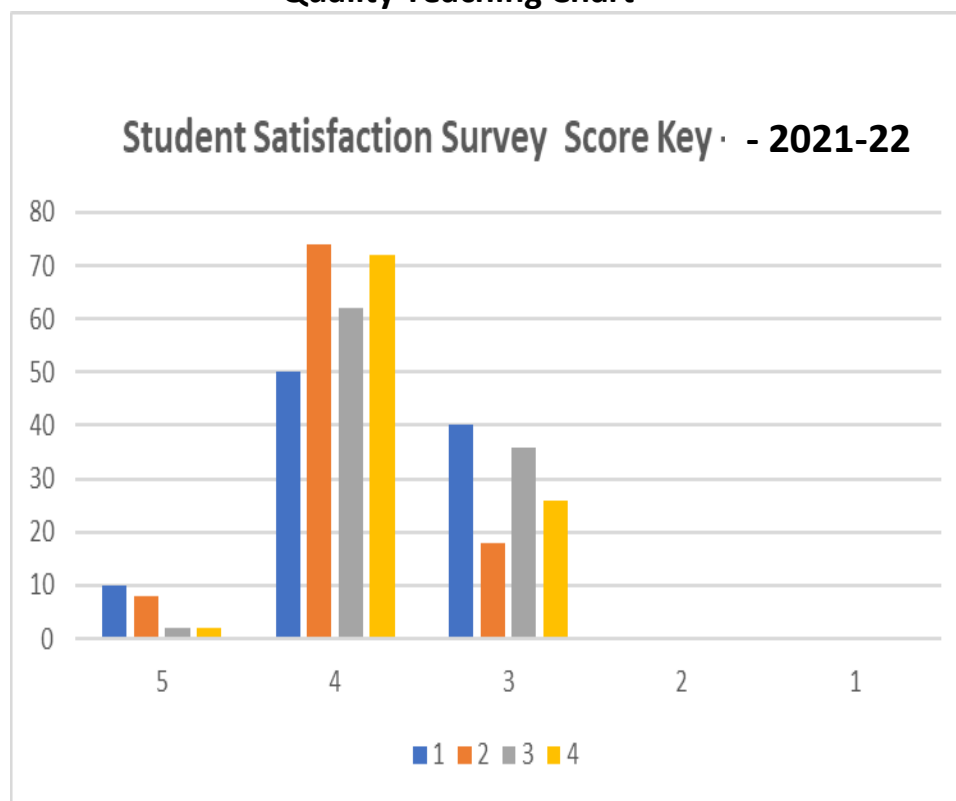
Student Satisfaction Survey Score Key -2021-22

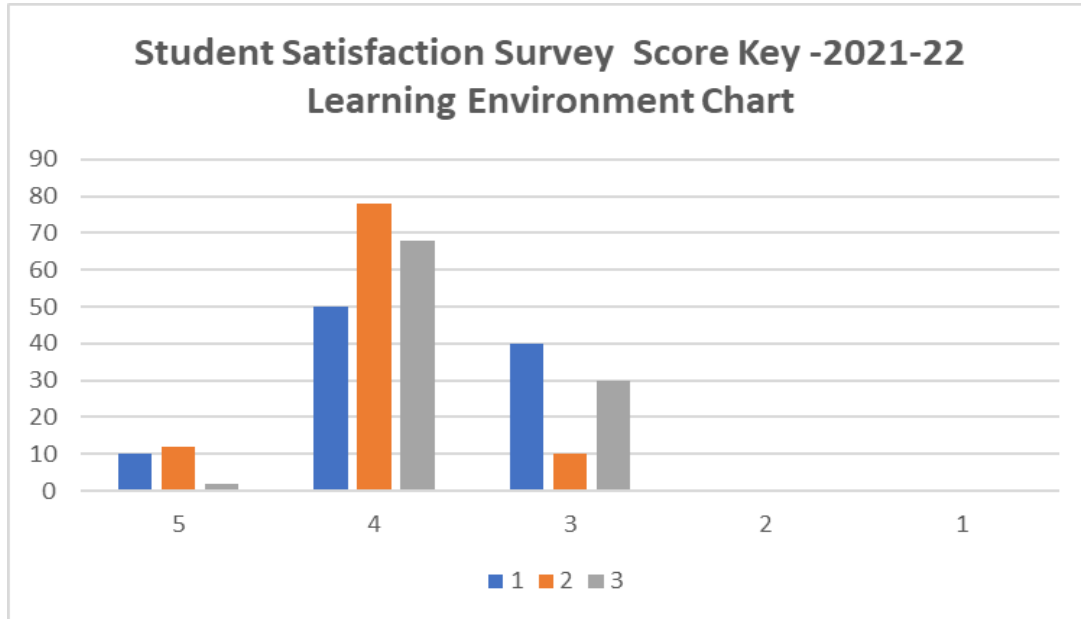

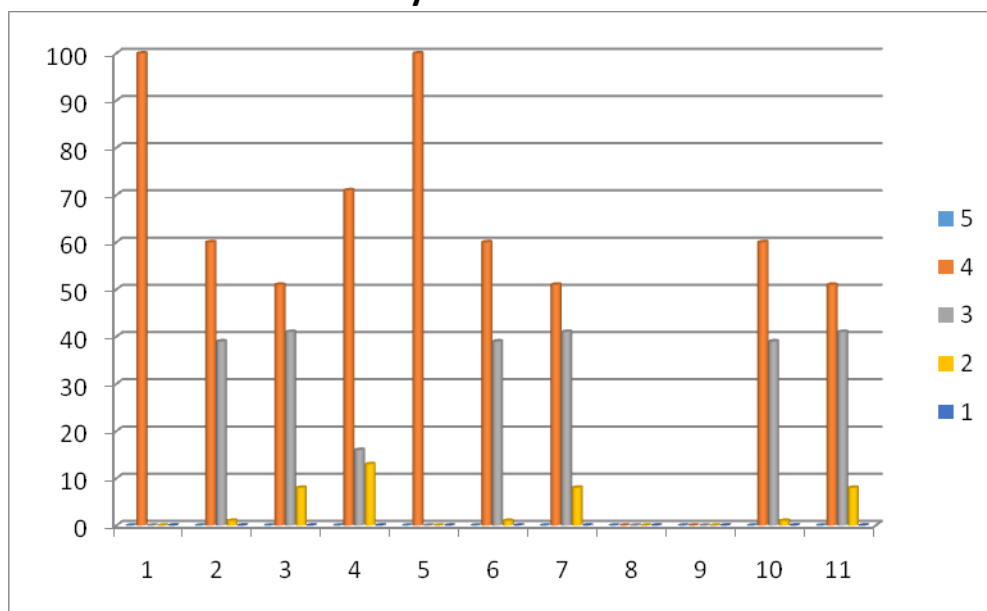

Analysis Report of SSS

Teaching Learning Process

- 80% Students stated that 85 to 100 % syllabus was covered and 20% students stated that 75 to 84 % syllabus was covered.
- 40% students perceived thorough preparation of teachers while 43% found it satisfactory & 17% found it poor.
- 50% students felt that teachers were always effective in communication while 40% found it to be sometimes effective and 10% found it to be just satisfactory.
- 75% students found teachers approach of teaching to be very good & internal evaluation to be very fare while 15% found it very good and 10% found it good.
- 90 % student stated that performance in assignments was discussed every time and 10% students stated that usually.
- 70 % students stated that assignments discuss every time while 29 % stated that usually and 1 % stated that sometimes.
- 55 % students found regular institutional interests in promoting activities & opportunities for students while 35 % found it usually and 10 % found it some time.
- 78 % students found Institutional facilitation in student's cognitive social and emotional growth was perceived to be significant while 12 % found it very well and 10 % found it moderate.
- Strong agreement was stated by 74% students for institutional provision of multiple opportunities to learn and grow while 26 % stated that agree.
- 51% students stated that teachers informed them, every time, about their expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes while 41 % stated that usually and 8% students stated that sometimes.
- 41 % students expressed that follow up of assigned tasks was along by the mentor every time while 51 % expressed that usually and 8 % expressed that occasionally.
- 78 % students pined that the teachers, every time, illustrate the concepts through examples & applications while 22 % pined that usually.
- 100 % Students stated that the teachers fully identify student's strengths & encourage them.
- Identification of student's weakness & provision of help by teachers was perceived to be every time usually by 60 % students while 39 % found it usually and 1% found it occasionally.
- 54 % students stated that the teachers use student centric methods to a great extent while 40 % stated that moderate and 05 % stated that some what.
- Strong agreement was expressed by 84 % students for encouragement by teachers to participate in extracurricular activities while 16 % was expressed agreement.
- 61 % students stated that the teaches make efforts to a great extent for making students ready for the world of work while 39 % stated that moderate.

- 75% students stated that use of ICT tools by teachers was above 90 % while 25 % stated that 70 – 89 %.
- Strong agreement was expressed by 70 % students for the overall quality of TLP in the college while 29 % students expressed agreement and 1 % students expressed neutral.

Quality of Teaching

- 85% students were satisfied with the quality of teaching, value obtained from the course content & relevance of the curriculum.

Learning Environment

- Campus was felt to be safe by 100% students.
- The diversity & quality of offered extra-curricular activities was satisfactory for 71 % students.
- College administrative staff was found to be helpful by 80% students.

Facilities

Library facilities, classrooms & lavatories, provision for parking, sports & fitness facilities and career counseling and facilities were satisfactory for the students.
